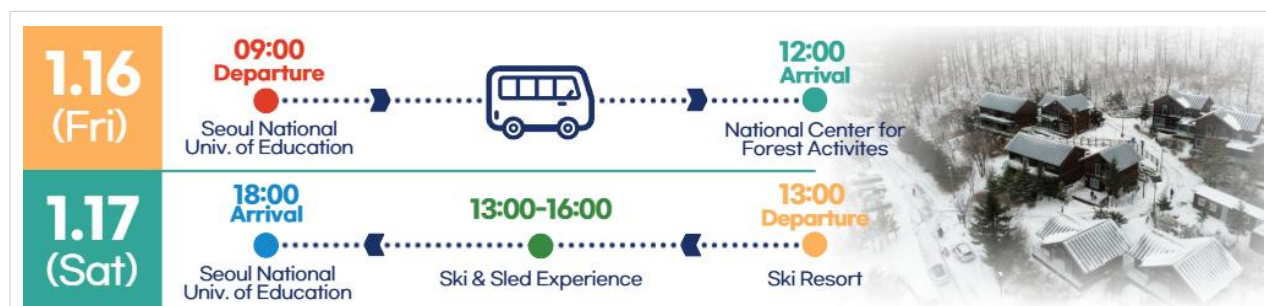

- **General Division:** Independent research papers on creative or academic topics
- ※ Open to individuals or teams, including university (graduate) students, advisors, researchers, and inventors both in Korea and abroad.

2. Fields of Submission

- Research papers on inventive or patented technologies and advanced ideas
- Studies on environment, ESG management, and future intellectual property
- Papers in humanities, economics, social sciences, or sports
- Advanced academic materials based on previously presented inventions or papers

3. Submission Guidelines

- **Deadline:** By December 12 (Fri), 2025, 18:00 (KST)
- **How to Apply:** Submit application form and presentation video
 - ※ File Format: HWP (.hwp) or MS Word (.doc / .docx)
 - ※ Presentation Video: Within 5 minutes, .mp4 format (recommended under 300 MB)
- **Submission Email:** Lee37895661@gmail.com
 - ※ Up to 5 participants (including main author, co-authors, and advisors) may be registered per team.

4. Important Notes

- Each submission must include an Abstract, a presentation video (within 5 min), and 1–2 photos to be included in the proceedings.
- Optional: A full paper (up to 5 pages, A4 size) may be submitted as an appendix.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring copyright clearance of all media used (photos, graphics, background music, etc.).
- ICPC is a creative research conference; it is not related to SCI or SSCI-indexed journals.
- On-site presentations are limited to those selected during the preliminary screening.
